

Booking Policy

Room Bookings

We are unable to cater for large group bookings. Children of all ages are most welcome, a travel cot and/or guest bed can be accommodated in most of our rooms.

Minimum Stay

Bookings are taken for a minimum stay of 2 nights during the high season, we will take shorter bookings where availability allows. Please contact us to discuss

Dogs

At The Merrymoor we love dogs, and Mawgan Porth is a dog friendly beach all year. Indeed our own dogs 'Lemmy and Lola' love to get wet in the rock pools and dig huge holes in the sand!

One dog is welcome in each guest room. Please note dogs are welcome in the bar but are not permitted in breakfast dining area. A £10 charge per dog is made to cover the cost of deep cleaning the room

All dogs must be well behaved and house trained

Please ensure you take your dog with you when you go out , there are lots of dog friendly places to visit

Smoking

We thank you for not smoking inside The Merrymoor, smoking extinguisher bins are situated outside the building. A surcharge of £50 will be applied to any room bill where a guest has smoked in the bedroom

Deposit

A non refundable deposit equivalent to a 1 nights stay is required to secure your booking. The balance of your stay is payable on departure.

Where a guest wishes to change their booking to alternative dates the deposit will be transferred.

In the event of cancellation within 21 days of arrival, guests are required to make full payment unless the room is successfully re- booked. We therefore recommend taking out holiday cancellation insurance

Check in

Your room will be ready from 2pm on arrival and we request you check out at 10.30am on departure day
